# 1. Current and expected evolution of the Romanian economy



Romania is the 2nd largest market in Central Eastern Europe after Poland and one of the most dynamic economies in the EU.

For 2021, the revised economic growth forecast is of 6.7% from 4.2% after strong positive dynamics in Q4 2020 and Q1 2021. Romania is already officially out of the COVID19 recession.

The Romanian government is committed to implement a set of ambitious reforms. These as part of the agreement with the EC and will be financially covered also by the EU Recovery and Resilience Plan.

#### 2. The Romanian market of hospital equipment and med-tech



The Romanian market of hospital equipment and med-tech is reliant on imports due to the absence of local large manufacturers.

Considering the new investments, up-grading and modernisations of public hospitals announced in Romania to take place for the next 6-7 years, as well as the further expansion of the private healthcare networks, it is expected that the Romanian market of hospital equipment and medtech to register a considerable growth of 5-6% every year till 2027.

Major players on the market include: Philips, GE Healthcare, Medtronic, Oxoid, Varian, Johnson & Johnson, Beckman Coulter, Olympus, Greiner, Nihon Kohden, Becton Dickinson, Bioomerieux, Trinity Biotech.



### 3. Announced investments in the Romanian public healthcare system



In 2020, there were 535 hospitals operating in Romania.

The Romanian public healthcare system is currently receiving considerable attention from international investors, such as the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, the European Investment Bank and the World Bank.

Also, funding is available from EU programs and the recently launched National Recovery and Resilience Facility.

Total allocated sum for the period 2021 - 2027 is of approx 4 bnEUR

As committed in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan, in 2021 will come into being the National Agency for Development of Health Infrastructure.

The Agency will be a separate legal entity, subordinated to the MoH.

Its portfolio will include infrastructure projects of national and regional importance, starting with the regional hospitals.

ANDIS will benefit in the first three years (2021-2023) from EIB's technical assistance though the PASSA mechanism, employing EU funds.







2020 vs 2019



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# 6. Analysis of the procurement procedures in the Romanian public healthcare



Except for especially regulated cases, all Public Purchasing procedures are transparent and are conducted throughout the public procurement portal (SEAP), mostly via electronic means communications. However, for a foreigner to register into SEAP can be rather cumbersome.

The Romanian public procurement system is extensively regulated and subject to constant scrutiny, both from the private sector and public actors; Therefore, the risks and challenges we see are mostly related to establishing an efficient and qualified bid department, able to swiftly identify new opportunities and manage on going processes

Potential risks might arise from insufficient or un-qualified personnel managing the public procurement process, leading to publication of incorrect award documentations and vitiated evaluation procedures.

Such risks could be mitigated by using the remedies system (appeals), which is well established and efficient. Hiring specialised technical and legal consultants should be considered.

Law no. 98/2016 on public procurement - regulates the general legal framework applicable to public procurement procedures
