

RAIL MODERNISATION PROJECTS IN EMERGING EUROPE

- Especially in the context of Ukraine's post-war reconstruction, countries such as Romania, Poland and Bulgaria represent key regional players in the logistic support component. For more details contact FRD Center at email europa@frdcenter.ro
- The European Investment Bank (EIB) allocated 50 mEUR to upgrade Ukraine's rail border crossings with Poland, Slovakia, Hungary and Romania. This investment is part of the EU-Ukraine Solidarity Lanes initiative. It is also co-financed by European Union's Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) and it aims to enhance trade and connectivity between Ukraine and the European Union.
- For example, Romania has a strategic importance for international logistics in the region and Constanta Port is expected to become a key logistics hub for Ukraine's reconstruction.

RAIL MODERNISATION PROJECTS IN ROMANIA

In Romania, the project of modernising the Bucharest-Craiova railway in Southern part of the country is progressing nicely. The Ministry of Transport has made public two draft Government Decisions for the approval of technical and economic indicators, which provide that most of the route will be able to travel at 200 km/h in the future. The Bucharest North-Videle-Roşiori-Craiova railway line, with a length of 95.5 km, is part of the southern branch of the Rhine-Danube Corridor. It ensures the connection between the northern branch of the Rhine-Danube Corridor and the Orient/East-Mediterranean Corridor (Curtici-Arad-Caransebeş-Drobeta Tr.Severin-Craiova-Calafat), as well as with the route of the former Pan-European Corridor IX.

The total value of the investment (including VAT) is set at over 2 bnEUR, out of which the actual construction and assembly works (including VAT) is 1.4 bnEUR. The execution period is set at three years.



RAIL MODERNISATION PROJECTS IN ROMANIA

There are numerous projects and plans for the modernisation of the Romanian railways.

According to the Romanian Government, here are a few examples:

- purchase of 37 interregional electric trains for railway passenger transport
- purchase of 62 units of new rolling stock for regional and suburban passenger railway transport
- purchase of 23 new 4-axle electric locomotives with ERTMS systems
- construction of 429.97 km of new railway electrified lines
- increasing the modal share of rail transport on the domestic intercity land passenger transport market (target: 9.5% in 2030 compared to 4.6% in 2015)
- making the rail passenger transport more efficient through the passenger traffic density and the number of new trains used in the rail passenger transport (target: +59% in 2030 compared to 2021)
- increasing the commercial speed of the passenger trains (target: 45 km/h in 2030 compared to 41.58 km/h in 2017)
- increasing the length of the railway network equipped with ERTMS under construction (target: 1,539.96 km in 2030 compared to 423.9 km in 2022)

RAIL MODERNISATION PROJECTS IN POLAND

Railway investments in Poland are financed through various vehicles, such as National Recovery and Resilience Plan (KPO), the European Funds for Infrastructure, Climate, Environment, the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF), the European Funds for Eastern Poland Programme and Regional Programmes etc.

A total of approx. 8 bnEUR from EU funds in 2021-2027 will allow for the further development of the Polish railway infrastructure, the purchase of modern trains and the implementation of digital traffic control systems.

Recently, the Polish Ministry of Infrastructure has announced an investment of 2.5 bnEUR through the National Recovery and Resilience Plan for the modernisation of railway lines across the country.

This money will be used by PKP Polskie Linie Kolejowe to modernise 800 km of lines of the Polish rail network.

RAIL MODERNISATION PROJECTS IN BULGARIA



A strategic investment of over 10 mEUR to enhance Burgas Port rail infrastructure, under the initiative "Connections from East to West," was announced by the Bulgarian Ministry of Transport and Communications in view of further positioning the country as a bridge between major European and global trade corridors.

The main objective of this investment is to improve rail access to Burgas Port and to promote a modal shift by improving efficiency of handling and shunting procedures. It marks an important milestone in their efforts to position Bulgaria as a main logistics player in Southeast Europe.

Recently, the same authority has launched a procedure to support intermodal operators and to develop the existing terminals. The total amount of funding provided by the Transport Connectivity Programme 2021-2027 is 17.5 mEUR. The deadline for submitting project proposals is September 26, 2025.
